

This year's awards program is dedicated to a dear friend of the American Saddlebred, Sonja Hardy. Sonja passed away on October 15<sup>th</sup> 2020 at her home in Avon, Maine. Sonja's enthusiastic love of horses led her to work in the industry for many years. During her career, she worked with Saddlebreds and Hackney ponies (as well as other breeds) including a stint with renowned Saddlebred trainer Jan Lukens at Lukens Stables, Ravena, New York. In Maine, she worked with Tina Constantine at Walnut Hill Stable, Cape Elizabeth; and with Janet Morris at Long Meadow Farm in Wilton.

Many of you will remember Sonja for her love of parades and costumes. She frequently attended parades with her horses and especially loved to dress them up at Halloween time. Haunted barns were one of her most loved attractions. The mid-evil period always captivated her. She even attempted a game of jousting at one time. Sonja always said, "I can't ride them but I can train them," which was not true because she was a good rider as well as ground trainer. In the early 2000s on the MHA circuit, she successfully campaigned Stella Rosette for Janet Morris and was instrumental in starting the show career a young Jean Pool, who is now owned and shown by Courtney Grant.

Sonja's infectious love of all things horse made her a fun person to be around. She loved to try anything new as long as it had to do with a horse. Over the years she helped many riders and drivers get into the show ring always made sure they enjoyed themselves. Sonja had a wonderful, fun loving spirit and will be greatly missed by all of those whose lives she touched.

#### 2020 ASAM POST SECONDARY SCHOLARSHIP

The American Saddlebred Association of Maine (ASAM) supports the educational aspirations of previous youth members by providing a yearly \$ 500.00 scholarship to an outstanding young man or woman who will be, or is currently, enrolled in a post secondary educational program. The applicant must be a Maine resident who is currently a member in good standing with ASAM and who had previously been a youth member for a full annual year.

This scholarship will be awarded annually to a high school senior or college student who plans to continue their education in college, technical or trade school, or an apprenticeship. NOTE: It does not have to be an equine-related career! The scholarship will be paid directly to the applicant after receiving a written request, along with proof of acceptance to a post secondary program and evidence of completion of their first semester (or equivalent period of training). Scholarship must be paid to student within two years after it is awarded.

Selection will be based on applicant's ability and aptitude for serious study, and/or community service, leadership, and achievements. This will not be a need-based award, therefore applicants should not disclose personal financial information. Previous winners are ineligible to participate a second time, but applicants who did not win are definitely encouraged to reapply! Applicants may have also applied for MHA or other horse association scholarships.
