Rules & Regulations:

- Any entries incurring bank fees will be charged \$50 plus cost of the bank fee and the original bill.
- Refunds will be made upon receipt of a vet certificate (or Dr); must be received by show manager before end of show. Office Fee is not refundable.
- Every Class recognized by MHA will be conducted and judged under the current rules of MHA.
- Every Class recognized by NEHC will be conducted and judged under the current rules of NEHC.
- Six ribbons awarded per class. Prize money as indicated: \$100: \$50, \$35, \$15, \$5.
All prize money will be taken off of your show bill automatically. Trophies awarded in all other classes.
- The ASAM Inc. Show Committee, its agents or employees, or the Hollis Equestrian Park will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to rider, groom, attendant, spectator, animal, or equipment at the show. Nor will any of the mentioned be held responsible for loss or destruction of any property or equipment or damage to or by animals at the Show or on the grounds.
- WARNING: Under Maine State Law an equine professional has limited liability for an injury or death resulting from the inherent risks of any equine activities.
- No one may speak to any judge without permission from the steward and show manager and only after the show has been completed.
- Post entries must be made a minimum of 3 classes prior to the entered class.
- No dogs on the show grounds unless kept on a least away from the show ring.
- No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the show grounds.
- PROOF of current rabies, negative Coggins, vaccinations (Rhino, Influenza, EEE, WEE, etc) & registration papers (breed classes) will be required to show.

A pleasure driving class to a two or 4 wheeled vehicle and are judged primarily on the suitability of the horse or pony to provide a pleasure drive.. Must show both ways of the ring at a walk, slow trot, working trot and strong trot and back readily. To be judged on Manners , Performance and Suitability

*** Competitors enter the ring at a walk, showing a working trot, slowing and extending the trot in both directions. Each driver individually must back their horse/pony in the line up followed by a forward step.. to be judge on Turnout, Attire, Whip , Gaits, Manners and Drivers Skill
